-AMC calc when a single unit is selected:

Considered Quarter: If the selected quarter has been closed by the unit it is used the selected quarter, if not, it is considered the last closed quarter.

$AMC = (\text{dispensed on the Considered Quarter}) / (90 - (\text{out of stock on the Considered Quarter})) * 30$

-AMC calc when an administrative unit is selected:

Considered Quarter: selected quarter.

Number of Units Considered on the Average (NU): Number of units of the selected administrative unit with the Considered Quarter closed.

$AMC = (\text{dispensed on the Considered Quarter} / NU) / (90 - (\text{out of stock on the Considered Quarter} / NU)) * 30$
