Display a warning message if zero remains for at least units per days or days per week.- Replace the label "'Name of the medicine* Dosage is not defined" to "'Name of the medicine* Units per day and Days per week cannot be zero" for the current message related to the validation process mentioned above.- Display confirmation dialog boxes before deleting phases and medicines.-
