Problem: When user closes QuanTB, the system just ask if the user confirms the operation. If user confirms, QuanTB closes all documents, and any unsaved data is lost.			
Solution: When the user closes QuanTB, the system must check if there is any unsaved document, i.e, documents that were changed and not saved. If there is any unsaved document, the system will ask the user if he wants to save the document before close. Check flow for each document in issue #660 .
